CSRP & DLRP Summer Programs 2025



The Distribution Load Relief program (DLRP) and the Commercial System Relief program (CSRP) are available across all 5 boroughs in NYC and Westchester.

SMART GRID will set up detailed curtailment solutions to help customers expand on their current curtailment efforts to reap a large reward. Based on your operations, you may qualify to participate in the DLRP and the CSRP or any Demand Response Program.



SMART GRID will send your facility a check for your participation. Make sure to maximize your curtailment effort so you maximize your revenue. We also handle every step of the registration process, eliminating the application and paperwork for your staff.

CSRP PROGRAM PARTAMETERS



- The CSRP program is a peak shaving program utilized as a response to system-wide peak demand, the program is called upon once con Edison reaches its day-ahead peak load forecast threshold.

Program Period	May - September	
Call Period	Monday – Friday (excluding holidays)	4 hours (usually 2pm – 6 pm)
Notification	Day-Ahead Day-of	21 hours 2 hours

The DLRP program parameters

The DLRP program is a contingency program designed to strengthen service reliability by reducing load to prevent demand from suppressing capacity. This program is called upon when Con Edison experiences voltage reduction, system network outages, or stress on the distribution system.



Program Period	May - September	
Call Period	Monday - Sunday	4 hours
Notification	Contingency Event Immediate Event	21 hours 2 hours

Lighting

Identify the spaces that are not in use during event times or a part of it and shut them off.



HVAC

Your AC dose not have to run in floors or rooms that are not in use or are cooled off.



Commercial Freezer's

A commercial freezer can be shut off for at least 4 hours without any damage to the food inside by keeping it closed.



Elevator's

Identify the elevators that are not so important to be in use during an event.

Schedule your dispatch verification event

Dispatch verifications are **critical** to ensuring you are ready to demonstrate full curtailment when dispatched in a real market event.

Sites that complete a DV perform 20% better in their first market event, leading to more cash in your pocket.

- The event time will follow normal program hours (see program summary slide)
- All dispatch communications will be used (emails, text, phone call) ← make sure we have all your site content info!
